

# MATTRESS RECYCLING

## RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

**Marshfield** will stop accepting mattresses & box springs during weekly curbside and drop off as of **January 1, 2023** but at the same time will begin allowing residents (with transfer station stickers) to recycle mattresses/box springs for a fee of \$35.

Residential customers with mixed loads will be charged as weigh and pay, plus an addition \$35 for each mattress or box spring in the load. At the Transfer Station, residents will be responsible for separating mattresses/box springs and placing each item in the appropriate container in an organized manner. **The fees will be paid at transfer station.**

Residents can choose to have their mattresses/box spring picked up curbside on the 3rd Thursday of each month by appointment. **Contact DPW Office 965 Plain Street @ 781-834-5575, (ext. 4) to schedule pick up.**

## ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING

- **Single, double, queen, king, California king; traditional mattresses constructed of metal, textiles, wood, and foam, includes crib mattresses and memory foam mattresses.**

## UNACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING

- **Excessively torn, puncture, soiled, or moldy items**
- **Twisted or crushed**
- **Wet or frozen or infested with bed bugs or mice**
- **Futons and fold out sofa beds**
- **Mattress pads and toppers**
- **Infant sleeping pads; air or water beds; any other furniture or textiles**

# MATTRESS RECYCLING

## COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

Beginning June 1, 2021, Commercial Customers will be charged a \$75 fee for each mattress or box spring brought to Marshfield transfer station. Commercial customers that continue to have mixed loads, which include mattresses/box springs, will be processed through weigh/pay, plus \$75 per mattress/box spring.

Commercial customers will be responsible for separating all mattresses/box springs from the load and for stacking these items in the appropriate container in an organized manner.

## ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING

- **Single, double, queen, king, California king; traditional mattresses constructed of metal, textiles, wood, and foam, includes crib mattresses and memory foam mattresses**

## UNACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING

- **Excessively torn, puncture, soiled, or moldy items**
