Re: Green Harbor Dredging & Shoaling conditions

Mariners are advised to use caution while transiting the Green Harbor entrance channel, especially during periods of low tide. The entrance channel has sustained substantial shoaling of approximately 10,000 cubic yards of sand due to the relentless Nor' Easterers this past winter. The United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) will be conducting maintenance dredging of the narrows during the period **30 April thru 7 May 2010** with the hydraulic dredging vessel "**Currituck**". We are optimistic that the channel will not be impeded during this short project. The Currituck will be working on a 24 hour schedule (weather permitting). All mariners are advised to use caution while transiting the Harbor and entrance channel. Please show courtesy to the working crews as they continue to enhance our Harbor. The Currituck crew will be monitoring channels VHF 16 & 13.
