How to Search for Available Permits and Licenses In the Storefront

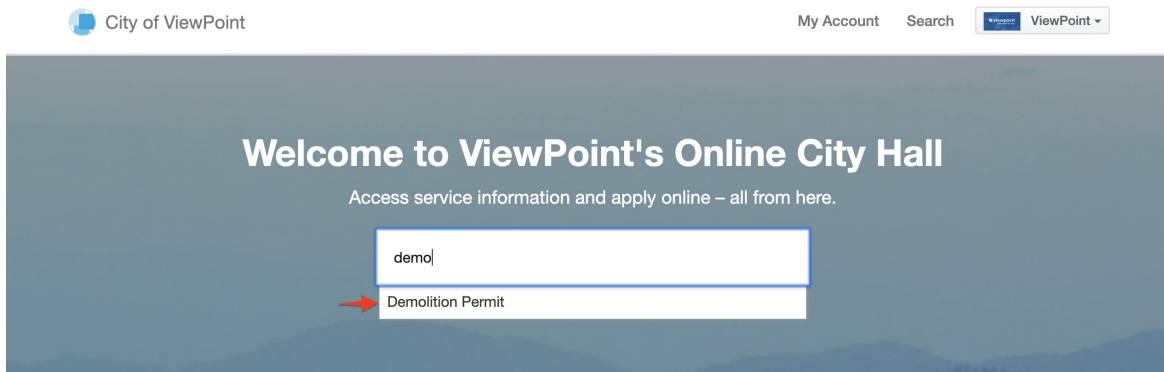

If you would like to quickly search to see if the permit or license that you would like to apply for is available online, simply use the search feature! Start typing the name of the permit and relevant search results will populate. The more text that you enter into the search bar, the more specific the results will be.
