Veteran's Park Project Improvements: Bill Finn, environmental advisor to the Conservation Commission, updated the Board on the status of Veteran's Park project, ATM20. The purpose of the project is to remove the dam and fish ladder and return it to its natural state, improving the passage of fish to the South River. Improvements to failing park features will also enhance the access and view for the public. All major permits will have been submitted by the end of the month. Once permits are in place they can finish the design. Design is considered 60% – 90% complete, depending on the need for alterations from permit feedback.

Project Construction is estimated at \$2.6 million. B Finn is working diligently to acquire various outside grants to cover these costs.

- S Merrick asked what would be done with the existing water wheel. B Finn answered that the feature would remain, as requested by the veterans.
- D Kelleher appreciated the efforts made to work together with the veterans.
- B O'Donnell said the park is in need of a rehab; the fish have a difficult time making passage. He also commented that the biggest expense is in maintaining the features, and that when the Project was proposed by Former Conservation Agent Grafton that no further CPC funds would be requested.
