Some are posing as the Social Security Office and the scammers are able to replicate the phone # of social security that shows on the screen. Cat fishing is where a phony profile is set up for scams. Patrick O'Connor had drafted legislation to assist consumers in dealing with robotic calls. The federal trade commission is a possible resource for fraud related complaints.
