

SHUTTLE BUS DRIVER/CUSTODIAN

(Council on Aging

(Safety Sensitive Employees)

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES: Provides transportation services via the Council on Aging senior bus as assigned and/or scheduled. Performs building maintenance duties as assigned by the Director.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Works directly under and reports to the Director of the Council on Aging

SUPERVISION EXERCISED: Oversees the volunteer bus escorts.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- 1. Adheres to driving/bus policy as determined by the Council on Aging
- 2. Keeps daily records of mileage, gasoline, oil usage and passenger log
- 3. Keeps routine check on the vehicle including tires, oil, directional signals; and removes debris daily and sweeps the bus once per week
- 4. Reports deficiencies/problems with the vehicle to the Director as soon as possible. Log this problem onto the driver sheet as well
- 5. Assists passengers in getting on and off the bus by opening the doors and offering physical assistance where appropriate
- 6. Assists with carrying bundles as needed and ensures that the passenger has entered the house before proceeding to the next stop
- 7. Delivers meals on a substitution basis as needed
- 8. Utilizes / operates a mobile communication system
- 9. Locks and secures the vehicle at the end of each day
- 10. Attends pertinent training when necessary
- 11. Assist staff with transportation dispatch and scheduling for the bus
- 12. Perform data entry for transportation statistics if needed.
- 13. Performs other related duties as assigned.
- 14. Performs routine maintenance and cleaning as assigned by the Director.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Commercial Drivers License (CDL) preferred

- 2. Good driver record (any combination of training and experience in motor vehicle operation).
- 3. Courteous and sensitive to the needs of elders
- 4. Knowledge of streets/ roads/community facilities
- 5. Ability to understand and follow oral instructions
- 6. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and supervisor.
- 7. Ability to perform physical duties related to cleaning, maintenance, and set up for Senior Center programs and activities.
