

MINUTES – SELECTMEN’S MEETING

Monday, October 19, 2020

Mr. Bradley moved, seconded by Mr. Darcy, to open the meeting at 6:45 p.m. The vote was 2:0. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Darcy - aye.

Wicked Women Makers Market – Michael Maresco said that the applicants have secured the Winslow House for this outdoor event which is scheduled to take place on November 28, 2020. After a brief discussion, Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Steve Darcy, to grant an entertainment license for this event contingent on positive recommendations from Police, Fire and Board of Health. The vote was 2:0. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Darcy - aye.

Vote to Declare Items as Surplus for Auction or Destruction – Mike Bradley read through the list of items submitted by Patrick Dello Russo. Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Steve Darcy, to declare these items as surplus. The vote was 2:0. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Darcy - aye.

Authorization for Town Administrator to Sign Contracts – Michael Maresco said that the Board had approved this authorization three years ago for a three year term and recommended that they renew the authorization for the Town Administrator to sign contracts and Purchase Orders under \$300,000. Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Steve Darcy, to grant this authorization for another three year term. The vote was 2:0. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Darcy - aye.

Mounces Meadows Farmers License Agreement – Michael Maresco said that Bob Galvin has approved this license agreement facilitated by the Conservation Commission allowing Ronnie Simon to farm the town-owned land known as Mounces Meadow. Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Steve Darcy, to approve and sign this agreement. The vote was 2:0. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Darcy - aye.

Chris Rohland joined the meeting at 6:50 p.m.

Interim Fire Chief Contract – After a brief discussion, Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Chris Rohland, to approve and sign the Interim Fire Chief Employment Contract with Thomas Corbo as drafted by Town Counsel. Consulting Contract with William Hocking – After a brief discussion, Mike Bradley moved, seconded by Chris Rohland, to approve and sign the Memorandum of Understanding with William Hocking for consulting services as drafted by Town Counsel. The vote was unanimous. Roll Call vote: Mr. Bradley – aye; Mr. Rohland – aye; Mr. Darcy – aye.
