

MINUTES – SELECTMEN’S MEETING

Monday, May 2, 2016

Steve Robbins opened the meeting at 6:45 p.m. and noted that Matthew McDonough will be joining the meeting late.

Marshfield Fairgrounds – One Day Wine & Malt License (May 14, 2016) – Mr. Robbins stated that this application was withdrawn by the applicant.
