Mr. MacDonald motioned to abandon the Marshfield regulations for the town's marinas and adopt the Governor's regulations which cover: Boating and various other marine and inland waterway related activities, Workplace Safety and Reopening Standards for Recreational Boating Businesses and Workplace Safety and Reopening Standards for For-Hire Fishing and Charters. The motion was seconded and "Yes" was unanimous.

- 6. Blue Fish Cove

Brook Street at Foster Avenue testing will be moved from 9th Street. Blue Fish Cove will be added from last year's testing. The motion was seconded and "Yes" was unanimous.
