

**Board of Health Meeting**  
**Emergency Remote Participation Meeting**  
**May 28, 2020**

**Board of Health Meeting opened at 3:10 p.m.**

Mr. MacDonald motioned to open the meeting and asked for a vote to push the “Reorganization of the Marshfield Board of Health” and the vote on the “VNA of Cape Cod Extension of Contract” to the next meeting. A vote of “Yes” was unanimous.

**Mr. MacDonald motioned to abandon the Marshfield regulations for the town’s marinas and adopt the Governor’s regulations** which cover: Boating and various other marine and inland waterway related activities, Workplace Safety and Reopening Standards for Recreational Boating Businesses and Workplace Safety and Reopening Standards for For-Hire Fishing and Charters. The motion was seconded and “Yes” was unanimous.

**A motion to approve the testing of six beaches:**

1. Rexhame
2. Fieldston
3. Brook Street
4. Brant Rock
5. Green Harbor
6. Blue Fish Cove

Brook Street at Foster Avenue testing will be moved from 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Blue Fish Cove will be added from last year’s testing. The motion was seconded and “Yes” was unanimous.

A regular Board of Health meeting was proposed for June 3<sup>rd</sup>, Wednesday at 3:00pm where the **Reorganization of the Board of Health** and the vote to extend the **VNA of Cape Cod Contract** will be addressed.
