MASS HEALTH INSURANCE

Provides non-emergency transportation to and from covered services for MassHealth members insured under Standard or CommonHealth plans. MassHealth medical providers must complete and sign a Prescription for Transportation (PT-1) form and submit to MassHealth for approval. For more information, call 1-800-841-2900.

SOWING SEEDS

Provides volunteer transportation for medical and other appointments or shopping, Monday-Friday. 72 hour (excluding weekends) notice is required. Limit of three rides per month. Boston rides are available Tuesday - Thursday between 10:00 am and 3:00 pm. Boston rides are limited to once per month. To schedule, call 781-837-3337.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

COUNCIL ON AGING SHUTTLE

The Council on Aging (COA) provides local transportation services to Marshfield residents age 60 and older and the disabled. The Shuttle Buses are handicap-accessible.

The shuttle operates curb to curb service Monday through Friday (excluding holidays) between 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. The shuttle offers daily transportation to and from the Senior Center, regularly scheduled shopping at local supermarkets (including Food Pantry) & pharmacies, transportation to in-town medical appointments and hair salons. Suggested donation: \$1.75 one way; \$3.50 round trip; \$6.00 out of town shopping

VOLUNTEER TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM SPONSORED BY OLD COLONY PLANNING COUNCIL (OCPC)

Designed for elders and the disabled who are without any other means of transportation to get to necessary appointments. Volunteer drivers are recruited and assigned to eligible trips approved at the discretion of the Council on Aging.

Eligible trips include out of town medical appointments, treatments, prescription pickup, and mental health services. Also included is personal shopping for home-bound elders. Advance notice required. Rides dependent on driver availability.

Volunteers are reimbursed mileage and parking by the OCPC. Riders will be billed a suggested voluntary donation based on mileage each month. The program's financial viability is largely dependent upon these donations.

AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY

Provides transportation to South Shore Hospital & associated facilities. This is a door to door service offered by appointment. The Courtesy Coach serves Marshfield on Tues. & Thurs. between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM. To schedule, call 781-624-4350.

GATRA ADA DEMAND RESPONSE SERVICE

Provides transportation for ADA eligible individuals who are unable to use accessible public fixed-route bus services. To schedule, call 1-800-759-8900 on Monday-Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.
