

## Marshfield Historical Commission Minutes

Meeting of June 1, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7PM in Hearing room 2 at the town hall. Attending were Cindy Castro, Barbara Carney, Kathy Sullivan, Michele Campion, Carolyn Shanley and Norma Haskins.

Demolition Application 22 Breakwater Court- After review Cindy made a motion, seconded by Barbara that this house has no historical significance to the Town and we would have no objection to the issuance of a demolition permit. It was voted and passed, unanimously.

Demolition application- 195 Webster Ave- Cindy reports this house has sustained a house fire recently. After review Cindy made a motion, seconded by Barbra that this house has no historical significance to the Town and we would have no objection to the issuance of a demolition permit. It was voted and passed, unanimously.

Demolition application- 239 Dyke Road- This building is part of the Green Harbor Marina. After review Cindy made a motion, seconded by Michele, that this building has no historical significance to the Town and we would have no objection to the issuance of a demolition permit. It was voted and passed, unanimously.

Treasurers Report- Michele reports the balance remaining in our budget is \$2748. From that amount we have spent \$2086.00 to have the roof repaired on the law office. After a brief discussion Michele made a motion, seconded by Kathy to set aside the remaining \$662.00 for a lap top computer for our new office. It was voted and passed, unanimously. Cindy to have the IT Dept. assist with that purchase.

Secretary's report- After Kathy made an amendment Cindy made a motion, seconded by Barbara to accept the minutes of our meeting of May 4<sup>th</sup> as amended. It was voted and passed, unanimously.

Training Green applications- The Commission discussed and approved the following uses of the training green.

- L. First Congregational Church would like the green for their Church Fair on July 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.
2. The Marshfield Farmers Market would like the use of the green on August 6, August 20, and August 27<sup>th</sup> for their market.
3. Grad Night Live would like the use of the green from May 20<sup>th</sup> thru June 10<sup>th</sup> for MHS Student Pictures.
4. Michelle Gregory would like the use of the green on Monday and Friday mornings from 9AM to 10AM for Yoga instruction from July and August.

Granite Markers- Norma reports the markers should be delivered as they are ready starting and 1-2 weeks.

Pratt Farm- Cindy reports the Town is selling the barn that still remains at the Pratt Farm.
