Meeting of June 6, 2023

Meeting called to order at 7:03PM in the Historical Commission Office. Attending were Cindy Castro, Kathy Sullivan, Michele Campion, Jack Arouca, Carolyn Shanley and Norma Haskins.

Demolition Application- 10 Charlotte St- After review Cindy made a motion, seconded by Jack that this cottage has no historical significance to the Town and we would have no objection to the issuance of a demolition permit. It was voted and passed, unanimously.

Demolition application- 1187 Ferry Street- Cindy reviewed. After review she made a motion, seconded by Jack that this cottage has no historical significance to the Town and we would have no objection to the issuance of a demolition permit. It was voted and passed, unanimously. She made a statement following that we would have comments should any Zoning Board of Appeals hold a hearing on this project.

School Visits- The school visits to the Concord Coach and the Law Office are almost complete. Everyone seemed to enjoy learning about both of our historic places. The entire third grade at all Marshfield schools will have been.

The Historic Homes list is still being worked on and project is ongoing.
