- The meeting was opened at 11:17
- Joe noted that everything has been sent to ISO and he is waiting for a response on the second PPI review.
- Greg noted that now that Kate the intern had left, he had contracted with BSC Group who was working to understand the OSP requirements. Joe noted he would help communicate with BSC to complete the maps.
- Joe reviewed all current estimated points which were estimated to be as follows:
 - Hazard Mitigation Plan- 215
 - PPI- 300
 - OSP- 800
- With a goal to get to a level 7 community, and needing about 300 points, Joe asked the committee on what points the committee should pursue.
- Doris suggested to look at activity 610 (flood warning and response) and 450 (Stormwater Management). Greg said some of those elements are completed by the Town.
- Joe suggested building off of OSP by pursuing NFOS. Greg noted that BSC could also perform NFOS work.
- Additionally, Joe suggested going for BC and FRB credit.
- Greg suggested we have both a member of the Board of Selectman, Emergency Management and Town Administrator at our July meeting to review our progress and plan the PPI approval.
- Joe assigned OSP and NFOS work to Greg to work with FRB and NFOS mapping. Joe would ask about BC credit.
- The meeting was closed at 12:12
