Public Hearing for Street Improvements to a Portion of California Street to Holyoke Ave

Jamie Bissonette presented for the applicant, Elliot Schneider. California Street is a private road off Holyoke Ave. The applicant is looking to improve California St within the right of way and provide improvements at the Holyoke Ave intersection. Holyoke Ave will be 20 ft. wide with a berm on each side and California St will be 18 ft. wide with a berm on each side. The applicant is proposing only one house lot.

Pat Brennan, from Amory Engineers presented a letter to the Board dated November 10, 2021 with 13 comments. HydroCad Drainage calculations show that the drainage will handle up to 100-year storm.

Mr. Guimond started that the Mr. Brennan's comments could be included as conditions of the approval. A long-term drainage plan needs to be developed for the area of Silver Pines. Boulders or a guardrail should be installed at the end of California St. to block access to the town owned land. The applicant needs to provide an as-built plan. DPW requires reinforced concrete pipe. DPW would also like bollards on Holyoke Ave

Ms. O'Donnell made a motion to close the public hearing for the Street Improvement for Plan for California St. Mr. Cantwell seconded. The vote was Ms. O'Donnell, aye; Mr. Pappastratis, Aye; Mr. Monaco, Aye; Mr. Cantwell, Aye.

Ms. O'Donnell asked if we should be looking at a penalty fee for incomplete or inaccurate application. Mr. Guimond said more applicant are taking advantage of pre-application meetings before filing.
