Gary Pina made a motion to accept the meeting minutes for May 26, 2021 Commission Meeting, Brian Robinson 2<sup>nd</sup> it.

Craig Jameson went over how Spring Programs went. Spring programs went very well considering COVID difficulties. Craig Jameson explained that with the warmer spring weather, the Rec Dept was able to get closer to normal with outdoor programs. Revenue has started to pick up and has continued at a good rate as we head into summer programs. Spring preschool soccer was a big success with about 90 children ages 2-6 participating.

Craig Jameson went over all upcoming summer programs and the revenue already brought in. He explained that we have great staff lined up for the summer and several different types of camps/programs for youth ages.

In addition, to youth programs, we are offering several Pickleball program options for adults at Peter Igo Park and MHS.

At Peter Igo Park the Recreation Department is in the process of getting proper conservation permitting with the help of the conservation dept and DPW.

Coast Guard Hill is being utilized more and more for sports on the field, adult fitness classes, volleyball, garden usage, and general leisure activities. Craig Jameson explained that we are excited to start building the new playground. The playground structure may take 6-8 weeks to be deliver, but the hope is to have it up this upcoming fall.

As of now we do not have any summer concerts scheduled. Looking for a band for possible an August Concert.

Field, courts, and recreational outdoor facility permits will continue to be given out through the summer. The new MyRec software is working very well and has made a huge difference in scheduling, sharing the calendar, and tracking fees.
