Installation of 90' of Heli coil foundation \$9,000.00

10% contingency \$12,716.00

Total cost of project \$139,876.00 approved by Committee.

The committee reviewed the Clift records with possible new names to list, records were hard to decipher. The following names will be added to the spreadsheet.

Spread sheet TW introduced the lasted changes to the honor roll spreadsheet. Currently 204 names on list. TW introduced possible changes by removing 18 names not listed as Marshfield residents of the list, after discussion 4 names will be removed from the list, other changes will require further discussion.

CC discussed the 13 brass stars proposed to be set in walkway, first estimates very expensive.

TW thinks stars could be made locally at a reasonable cost
