# **Policy Update**

A draft of "Publication of Student Images, Videos, and other Social Media" to be added to the "Acceptable Use Policy for Digital Learning and Communications" was presented as a 1<sup>st</sup> read. The intent is to tighten the current policy and includes images shared on school and personal accounts.

Mr. Greer requested that the suggested policy change be condensed. Mrs. Campbell mentioned that teachers' classroom sites should also be considered.

## FBMS One Book One School (OBOS)

FBMS Principal Maureen Kemmett, Assistant Principal Lisa Lynch, and Special Education Teacher Elizabeth Zimmer highlighted the OBOS for the upcoming year. This year marks the 10<sup>th</sup> for the OBOS program and has a theme of "Differences Make Us Stronger". For the first time, students and staff will choose one of 4 books: Linked, Count Me In, The Insiders, or The Colors of the Rain. Topics of the selections include acceptance of: religion, natural origin, gender orientation, race, and ethnicity. By offering students and staff a choice, UDL is modeled. For the first time, FBMS is asking students/staff to secure their own copy of their chosen book either at the library or by purchasing a book. Some of the selections are translated. The author of Count Me In, Varsha Bajaj, will visit FBMS in November.
