The Town of Marshfield received a grant to develop a Long-term Coastal Resiliency Plan.

The goal of the plan is to proactively address future coastal flooding and erosion risks under a changing climate. The plan will identify and prioritize the most at-risk sections of town and develop a set of guiding principles and recommended zoning policies that will allow the Town to proactively reduce vulnerabilities in these areas and, if necessary, rebuild in a more resilient way after a catastrophic event. Economic costs and benefits of different policy scenarios, including 'no action', will be explored. The project will NOT focus on engineering strategies like seawalls or beach nourishment.

Workshop attendees will learn about future coastal flood risks in the planning area and share their experiences, ideas, concerns, and preferences to assist in the development of policy scenarios.
