INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for " Reconstruct and Repave Ocean Street at Intersection Rte 3A, Marshfield, MA Contract 2018-06" will be received by the Department of Public Works at the Town Hall, 870 Moraine Street, Marshfield, Massachusetts until 2:00PM (prevailing time) on Thursday, October 12, 2017. At that time the bids will be taken to Hearing Room #2, 2nd floor of the Town Hall, to be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked " Bid-Reconstruct and Repave Ocean Street at Intersection Rte. 3A, Marshfield, MA, Contract 2018-06"

The work consists conducting full depth reconstruction of the Ocean Street Intersection at Route 3A including saw cutting pavement, pavement removal and disposal, repaving and restriping over several nights with specified traffic control plan and work should be done in accordance with specifications prepared by the Department of Public Works, Town of Marshfield, Massachusetts.

All proposals are subject to Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Labor and Industry rates, EEOC Regulations, M.G.L. Chapter 62C - Section 49A, Chapter 30 - Section 39M, and M.G.L. Chapter 149 ss26 and 27. Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications may be obtained after September 27 from the office of the DPW, Town Hall, 870 Moraine Street, only upon receipt of a \$25.00 refundable deposit check made payable to the Town of Marshfield. Documents will be mailed upon receipt of a \$15.00 non-refundable check or receipt of the recipients Fedex number All bidders shall be pre-qualified with the MassDOT and shall submit proof of this at the time of bid document pick up.
