

## EXHIBIT "A" GREEN HARBOR PARK MARSHFIELD, MA

#### GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SUMMARY

Present Site: Harbor dredge spoil area used for many years for material from harbor. A presently completed road crosses park area. A waste water treatment plant is immediately to north of site. Salt marsh surrounds site to south and west.

<u>Proposed Project:</u> Construct a passive park on spoil area and leave spoil site for future dredging.

Proposed Materials: Fill material for conture changes to come from existing dredge spoil. New gravel will be imported only for parking and paving base.

Spoil Area: Future spoil area will have 8' high berm between spoil and park.

Erosion Control: Hay bales double stacked shall secure limit of construction before any excavation commences.
