Affirmative Marketing Plan

Affirmative fair marketing of all the units shall be conducted to provide information, maximum opportunity, and otherwise attract eligible persons protected under state and federal civil rights laws that are least likely to apply in the Marshfield/Brockton market area.

SEB will coordinate all correspondences between Mill Creek Residential and MassHousing and/or the municipality related to the approval of the Affirmative Fair Housing Marketing Plan (AFHMP). This coordination between Mill Creek Residential and the municipality will be most important during the preparation and approval of the Final Approval application. SEB will then monitor MassHousing's review of the Final Approval application with respect to the AFHMP and answer questions and coordinate responses as required for approval of the AFHMP.

After the AFHMP has been approved by MassHousing as part of their Final Approval, and within 6 months of the estimated completion of the first affordable units, SEB will begin placing ads for the affordable units online on the websites listed on the following pages. The 60 day marketing period for the affordable units will start upon the publication of the first online ad.

Print Ads for the affordable units will run at least twice within the 60 day marketing period in the newspapers listed. The papers listed cover the Greater Boston and Norfolk area, and include papers to attract African-American, Hispanic and Chinese applicants.

According to the MLA Language Map Data Center, the Aggregate Data, 5-Year Summary File, 2006–2010 for Plymouth County shows that the no language other than English that is spoken by more than 5% of the population. Portuguese is spoken by 3.26%, Spanish is spoken by 2.64%, and French Creole is spoken by 1.91%.

SEB will also contact all the print advertisers and set up the first ad insertions for the affordable units in each paper so that the first print ads are place as quickly as possible in each publication. The second print ad will be run in each paper approximately 2 to 3 weeks after the first print ad.

Within a week of the online ads being posted, notices for the affordable units will also be sent to the organizations and social service groups listed herein. These local groups provide services for persons in the surrounding area who are considered least likely to apply. Additional community contact groups can be added to the marketing plan as directed by the Town.

CHAPA no longer posts developments on their website unless they are the monitoring agent but the affordable units will be placed on the Massachusetts Affordable Housing Registry (operated by CHAPA).

Households interested in the affordable units can respond to the ad by contacting SEB via phone or email and having materials mailed or emailed to them, depending on request. Information Packets and

Applications for the affordable units will also be available for download directly from the SEB Housing website.

Notices for the affordable units will also be sent to the organizations and social service groups listed on the following page. Information Packets and Applications will also be made available at the Ventress Memorial (15 Library Plaza, Marshfield, MA).

SEB will respond to inquiries by phone, e-mail & mail, where necessary on marketing materials. SEB will also provide guidance to applicants as to what the lottery application entails and the documentation that must be submitted and completed for entrance into the lottery. SEB will collect and review applications to determine if applications are complete. Households with incomplete applications will be given specific checklists of missing documentation to facilitate the completion process by the application deadline. SEB will review completed applications and determine if households are eligible according to affordable housing program guidelines.

SEB will notify all applicants as to eligibility status and organize and conduct the lottery (if there are more applicants than units available).

Immediately after the Lottery Date, SEB will notify all lottery households of their positions on each Waiting Lists (as established by the Lottery) and SEB will submit to the Management Team the Waiting Lists established the night of the lottery. The Waiting Lists submitted to the leasing office will contain all the contact information for each household and illustrate the order that applicants will be able to apply for, and if found eligible by the leasing office, reserve units.

The Developer will determine if the applicants qualify for a lease (credit checks, income/rent ratios etc.) using their own established management criteria assuming it confirms with all pertinent Fair Housing laws and regulations. The Developer will be responsible for tours of the units and for answering all questions regarding the property after eligibility certification.

Households who need TTY Services may use MassRelay to communicate over the phone. SEB has communicated with applicants through MassRelay for over 5 years. The SEB Development Directory (where interested households leave their contact information if they wish to be sent materials or have questions they want answered directly) will be checked daily during the lottery marketing period. Messages left thru MassRelay or other relay services will be returned on the same business day. All households shall have equal access to the SEB staff and the SEB Development Directory.

Modera Marshfield is aware of the FCC's guidelines on receiving Relay Services. The Leasing Office will not mistakenly assume that people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, or have a speech disability must come into the office to handle a matter in person even though other people are allowed to handle the same matter over the telephone.
