- 8,000 cubic yards of dredge spoils from Marshfield Yacht Club anticipated for Rexhame Beach nourishment
- Woods Hole Group retained to study beach sand transport models and alternatives for beach and dune nourishment at several locations

9. Shellfish closure of the North & South Rivers on Nov 1, 2020 (Per DMF)

 Based on recommendations of the FDA, MassDMF closed several areas to shellfishing due to suspected, insufficient dilution of near-by wastewater treatment plant effluent.

10. North/South River Pump out Service (Updates?)

- Green Harbor Town Pier public pump-out service is free and currently operable
- New pump-out service established at Green Harbor Marina fuel dock
- Roht Marine has a pump out service at their facility on the North River
- Scituate has added a new pump-out boat to their harbormaster's fleet
